



G7N RED SEA CRISIS

Red Sea Challenges: Impact on Freight Forwarders and Shipping Industry

The ongoing crisis in the Red Sea and continuous attacks by Houthi rebels on cargo ships are significantly affecting the freight forwarding industry. A recent report from maritime advisory firm Sea-Intelligence reveals the extent of these challenges, surpassing even the early hurdles posed by the pandemic.

According to Sea-Intelligence, known for tracking changes in vessel capacity, the Red Sea crisis now stands as the second-largest event impacting the supply chain in recent years, following only the 2021 Suez Canal blockage by the "Ever Given." The prolonged transit around the Cape of Good Hope is leading to a noticeable decrease in vessels available for container pickups at ports.



Unlike the COVID-19 pandemic, where high demand strained vessel capacity, the industry is now grappling with excess vessel capacity that can be strategically utilized to ease disruptions. Alan Murphy, CEO of Sea-Intelligence, notes that about 10% of the world's fleet is currently inactive, providing an opportunity to address the imbalance in vessel availability and improve scheduling certainty.

Houthi rebel attacks in the Red Sea are already causing more significant disruptions to the supply chain than the initial phases of the pandemic. However, unlike the pandemic period, there are new vessels available for deployment, offering a potential solution post-Chinese New Year. Experts suggest that adding vessels to the rotation will be crucial in mitigating delays caused by diversions around the Cape of Good Hope. These disruptions are impacting various industries, with companies like Tesla, Volvo, Michelin, and Ikea reporting manufacturing halts and product delays.

The effects extend beyond container delays, impacting energy markets and product tanker operators. Major companies like Shell and BP have halted shipments through the Red Sea, and diversions of LNG vessels to the Cape of Good Hope have increased since December. Shipping analysts warn of potential tanker shortages, leading companies to avoid the region.

The complexities of the Red Sea crisis are also influencing product tanker rates, resulting in double-digit gains in several Middle East Gulf routes. Shipping companies like Tom, Hafnia, Scorpio Tankers, and Ardmore could benefit from rising product tanker rates.

Despite U.S. counterattacks against the Houthis, it's estimated that rebel attacks in the Red Sea may continue for six months to a year. With ongoing threats to international shipping, the industry must respond strategically to ensure the safety of crews and cargo s





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
